I begin in the Name of Allah, Hir Rahman Nir Raheem (the Compassionate the Merciful).

1 . Ha Meem!

(٢)

2 . I swear by The Book that makes manifest.

3 . Surely We revealed it on a blessed night surely We are ever warning;

4 . Therein every wise affair is made distinct,

5 . A command from Us; surely We are the senders of *Rasools* (apostles),

6 . A mercy from your '*Rabb*', surely He is *Samee-ul Aleem* (The Hearer, The Knower)

7 . The '*Rabb*' of the heavens and the earth and what is between them, if you would be sure.

8 . There is no god but He; He gives life and causes death, your '*Rabb*' and the '*Rabb*' of your fathers of old.

9 . No, they are in doubt, they sport.

10 . Therefore keep waiting for the day when the heaven shall bring an evident smoke,

11 . That shall overtake men; this is a painful punishment.

12 . Our '*Rabb*'! remove from us the punishment; surely we are believers.

13 . How shall they be reminded, and there came to them an *Rasool* (apostle) making clear,

14 . Yet they turned their backs on him and said: One taught, a madman.

15 . Surely We will remove the punishment a little, but you will surely return to evil.

16 . On the day when We will seize them with the most violent seizing; surely We will inflict retribution.

17 . And certainly We tried before them the people of *Firon* (Pharoah), and there came to them a noble *Rasool* (apostle),

18 . Saying: Deliver to me the servants of **Allah**, surely I am a faithful *Rasool* (apostle) to you,

19 . And that do not exalt yourselves against **Allah**, surely I will bring to you a clear authority:

20 . And surely I take refuge with my '*Rabb*' and your '*Rabb*' that you should stone me to death:

21 . And if you do not believe in me, then leave me alone.

22 . Then he called upon his '*Rabb*': These are a guilty people.

23 . So go forth with My servants by night; surely you will be pursued:

24 . And leave the sea intervening; surely they are a host that shall be drowned.

25 . How many of the gardens and fountains have they left!

(٢٦)

26 . And cornfields and noble places!

(٢٧)

27 . And goodly things wherein they rejoiced;

(۲۸)

28 . Thus, and We gave them as a heritage to another people.

29 . So the heaven and the earth did not weep for them, nor were they respited.

30 . And certainly We delivered the children of Israel from the abasing punishment,

(۳۱)

31 . From *Firon* (Pharoah); surely he was haughty, one of the extravagant.

32 . And certainly We chose them, having knowledge, above the nations.

33 . And We gave them of the communications wherein was clear blessing.

34 . Most surely these do say: “

(۳۵)

35 . There is nothing but our first death and we shall not be raised again.

36 . So bring our fathers back, if you are truthful.

(۳۷)

37 . Are they better or the people of *Tubba* and those before them? We destroyed them, for surely they were guilty.

38 . And We did not create the heavens and the earth and what is between them in sport.

39 . We did not create them both but with the truth, but most of them do not know.

40 . Surely the day of separation is their appointed term, of all of them

(۴۱)

41 . The day on which a friend shall not avail his friend anything, nor shall they be helped,

(۴۲)

42. Save those on whom Allah shall have mercy; surely He is *Azeez-rur Raheem* (The Mighty, The Merciful).

43. Surely the tree of the *Zaqqum*,

(٤٤)

44. Is the food of the sinful

(٤٥)

45. Like dregs of oil; it shall boil in their bellies,

(٤٦)

46. Like the boiling of hot water.

47. Seize him, then drag him down into the middle of the blazing fire

48. Then pour above his head of the torment of the boiling water:

49. Taste; you forsooth are the mighty, the honourable:

50. Surely this is what you disputed about.

51 . Surely those who ward off evil are in a secure place,

(٥٢)

52 . In *Jannat* (garden) and springs;

(٥٣)

53 . They shall wear of fine and thick silk, sitting face to face;

(٥٤)

54 . Thus, and We will wed them with *Hoor's* pure, beautiful ones.

55 . They shall call therein for every fruit in security;

(٥٦)

56 . They shall not taste therein death except the first death, and He will save them from the punishment of the blazing fire

57 . A grace from your *Rabb*; that is the great achievement.

58 . So have We made it easy in your tongue that they may be mindful.

59 . Therefore wait; surely they are waiting.
